Mail Truck Mishap Results in Injury, Loss of Occupation

The old adage that delivering the mail in all types of weather and circumstances can be dangerous proved to be true for Jane Doe on January 28, 2003. Jane Doe was stopped, delivering mail for the U.S. Post Office when she was struck by a delivery truck that was traveling on the wrong side of the road. As a result of the crash, Ms. Doe underwent neck surgery and lost

her job with the U.S. Post Office. She was forced to retrain herself for another occupation as her injuries prevented her from returning to her mail carrier position. A substantial settlement was reached with the delivery company shortly before the case was set for trial.
